#### AWARD MOWING CONTRACT BID #20-03-002 TO SOUTHERN OAKS DBA SCOTT & COMPANY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$66,886 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE 2019/2020 FISCAL YEAR

On motion by Council member Buell second by Council member Roznovsky with all members present voting “aye” Mowing Contract Bid #20-03-002 was awarded to Southern Oaks DbA Scott & Company in an amount not to exceed \$66,886 for the remainder of the 2019/2020 fiscal year.

Mr. Yenne stated Lake Jackson now has 10 positive cases with 4 having recovered. He reported the golf course is closed and the Recreation Center, Jasmine Hall and Civic Center remain closed. Staff continues to work split shifts. Heavy trash and recycling remain suspended.
