Construction Schedule Change

To all those affected by the downtown construction we appreciate your patience. Construction has been slow and tedious with a few twists along the way. We anticipate that the contractor is 8 weeks behind the original published schedule.

Excavation has begun on the north side of the Circle Way/This Way intersection.

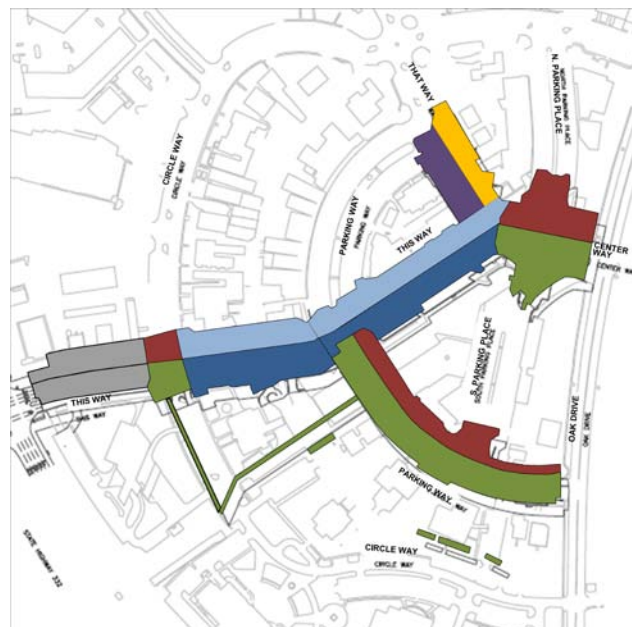
Concrete should be poured in three weeks and the intersection open to traffic 2 weeks thereafter.

Since the project is behind schedule, we have modified the construction sequence and will construct Phase 4 before Phase 3.

This decision was made in light of the upcoming holiday schedule and the lesser amount of intricate sidewalk work in Phase 4.

Construction on Phase 4 is scheduled to begin in October. However, construction will not begin on Phase 4 until all sidewalks in Phases 1 & 2 are complete.

We appreciate your patience and feedback on the project. If there is anything we can do to lessen the affects of construction project please let us know so we can respond.
