Incident: Update to Officer-Involved Shooting

The suspect in the Thursday, March 2, officer-involved shooting was Brett Cameron Carter, 34, of Sweeney, Texas. Two officers have been placed on administrative leave while other law enforcement agencies investigate the shooting. One of the officers has more than 30 years of law enforcement experience. The other officer has three years of experience.

As these investigations continue, the Lake Jackson Police Department cannot comment on certain aspects of them, but the department continues to be as transparent as it can.

“We are committed to working with the agencies that are a part of the officer-involved shooting,” said Lake Jackson Police Chief Paul Kibodeaux. “We are sharing the still shot of one of the officer’s bodycam videos in an effort to maintain transparency and accountability to our public. The Texas Rangers are involved in this investigation and we will continue to cooperate with them as they prepare the case for the Brazoria County grand jury.”

On the second page of this press release, a digital still of one of the officer’s bodycam videos reveals Carter exiting a truck wielding a large knife and facing officers. The moments before and after his exit are part of the Texas Ranger investigation.

Once the Texas Rangers have completed their investigation, the District Attorney will present the case to the grand jury.
