HEB

Any retail shopping bags (paper or plastic)
Produce bags (plastic)
Product overwrap film (non-food containment)
Bread bags (plastic)
Dry cleaning bags (plastic)
Newspaper bags (plastic)
The recycling box is in front of store in entryway

KROGER

Plastic bags
Plastic cereal and bread bags
Plastic dry-cleaning bags
Plastic resealable zipper bags

OFFICE DEPOT

Ink and toner cartridges (including laser cartridges)
Take to front register

TARGET

Glass all colors (please clean glass)
Plastic bottles
Aluminum cans
Plastic bags
Ink cartridges and toner cartridges for printer
Batteries – regular size AA, AAA, C, D, 9V
Old cell phones with battery

BEST BUY

Ink cartridges
Toner cartridges
Old cell phones, tablets, ipads, laptops
All in one computer (screen built in)
Desktops

LOWES

Compact fluorescent light bulbs (not tubes)
Plastic bags
Rechargeable batteries, AA, AAA, C, D, 9V to 20V (drill battery)
Bring to recycling boxes by customer service

HOME DEPOT

Compact fluorescent light bulbs (not tubes)
Rechargeable power tool batteries

KOHL'S

Plastic bags
Bring to recycling boxes in back of store near water fountains
